

RIGHTS OF VENDORS AGAINST UNDUE EVICTION AND RELOCATION

Street Vendors Act, 2014

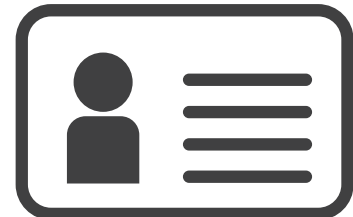


1 NO VENDOR CAN BE EVICTED UNTIL A SURVEY IS COMPLETE

It is illegal to evict a vendor before the Town Vending Committee (TVC) completes the survey and issues Certificates of Vending (COV) and Identity Cards to all vendors (Section 3)

2 NO VENDOR CAN BE EVICTED IF HE/SHE HAS A VALID COV

No vendor can be removed if he/she holds a valid COV and that COV is not suspended by the Town Vending Committee (Section 18)



3 NO VENDOR CAN BE EVICTED ON DECLARATION OF A NO-VENDING ZONE

If a municipal authority declares a zone to be a no-vending zone, vendors of that zone cannot be evicted. They should be relocated to a nearby area (Section 18)

4 NO VENDOR CAN BE EVICTED BY A POLICE OFFICER

The vendors can only be evicted by the local authority, on the recommendation of the TVC. Police officers do not have the power to evict vendors under the Act (Section 18)



5 NO VENDOR CAN BE EVICTED WITHOUT A 30 DAYS NOTICE

The local authority cannot evict or relocate vendors without serving him/her with a notice of 30 days prior to such eviction or relocation (Section 18)
