

# RIGHTS OF VENDORS AGAINST UNDUE SEIZURE

## Section 19

### Street Vendors Act, 2014



#### 1 SEIZURE FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH EVICTION OR RELOCATION ORDER

Vendors' goods may only be seized if they fail to comply with an eviction or relocation order.

#### 2 NO SEIZURE WITHOUT A 30 DAYS NOTICE

Vendors' goods cannot be seized unless they were served a notice of 30 days before eviction or relocation.



#### 3 NO SEIZURE WITHOUT A RECEIPT

Vendors should be provided with a copy of the list of goods seized, duly signed by the authorized person upon seizure.

#### 4 OPPORTUNITY TO RECLAIM THE SEIZED GOODS

Vendors can reclaim their seized goods from the local authority on payment of a fees as specified in the scheme.



#### 5 TIMELINE FOR RELEASING THE SEIZED GOODS

The seized goods must be released by the authority-

- On the same day as filing of claim by the vendors, in case of perishable goods.
- Within two days of filing the claim by the vendors, in case of non-perishable goods.
